2. Be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. Affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. Identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted.

- Description : A new 700 gallon per minute groundwater well (Well No. 9) will be constructed approximately 80' east of the east bank of White Lick Creek. The well will consist of a vertical turbine pump/motor placed on an elevated platform approximately 4' above the regulatory flood elevation. A 30" diameter concrete filled steel casing pipe around the pump well casing will be installed to structurally support the well platform. In addition, a new 6' by 11' by 7' deep concrete meter/valve vault will be constructed immediately adjacent to the well platform. Approximately 6" of the meter vault will be located above existing grade in the floodway. A flood tight hatch will be installed to protect interior process piping and meter from damage as a result of flooding. In addition, 462' of a 8" raw water main will be horizontally directionally drilled under the creek from the new well and will tie in with an existing 8" raw water main. Also, the existing access drive will be resurfaced with new gravel to match existing grade. Details of the project are contained in information and plans received at the Division of Water on October 14, 2011 and November 16, 2011.

Description : A 3000' section of the Erie-Lackawanna Trail will be constructed over an existing gravel path on top of the flood control levee along the north side of the river. The existing path will be widened and paved to an 8' wide path with 5' shoulders on each side. To achieve this widening, the top of the levee will be widened on the landward side and the side slopes adjusted to meet the existing toe of slope as much as possible. The existing slopes on the landward side will need to be stripped of the existing top soil and the remaining fill scarified to accept the new fill material. This work will be done under the US Army Corps of Engineers review and supervision. The new side slopes will be revegetated. Minor regrading of the river side of the levee will occur. The existing gravel trail leading south from an existing pedestrian bridge into Wicker Park will also be paved as part of this project. Minimal if any side slope work will be involved with this portion of the project. Details of the project are contained in information and plans received at the Division of Water on November 3, 2011.

- Description : The project purpose is to reconductor the 138kV circuit from the Northwest Substation to the Southwest Substation (132-04 line) to include the replacement of 5 lattice steel towers with 5 single shaft steel poles to achieve the required conductor loadings and National Electric Safety Code clearances. Concrete anchored Tower 337 lies within the floodway of Little Eagle Creek and shall be replaced with a concrete anchored single shaft steel pole and restrung as part of the overall project scope. The 8 foot diameter and 16.5 foot deep concrete anchor shall be brought slightly above grade and the steel replacement pole (approx. 3.45' diameter at base). - Location : The Northwest Substation to Southwest Substation Line Upgrade project is located in Speedway, Marion County, Indiana. The project corridor runs primarily north/south through Speedway, IN extending from the Northwest Substation near 30th Street and Lafayette Road, running south to the Southwest Substation near West Morris Street and South Warman Avenue. Tower 337, applicable to this permit, is located on the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Golf Course just north of 16th Street accessible through the maintenance building property near Speedway, Wayne Township, Marion County
