

Common Construction Wage Hearing Data – 2010

Summary of data collected from
January 1, 2010 through
December 31, 2010

Executive Summary

- ▶ 1387 Wage Scales were adopted in 603 hearings statewide in 2010 – 363 fewer scales than in 2009
- ▶ Hearings were conducted in 83 of Indiana's 92 Counties
- ▶ The following counties adopted the highest number of scales:
 - Marion: 215 scales
 - Hamilton: 116 scales
 - Allen: 107 scales

Executive Summary (Continued)

- ▶ The following counties had the highest number of separate hearings:
 - Lake: 68 hearings
 - Marion: 58 hearings
 - Allen: 31 hearings
- ▶ The following counties had the highest number of hearings on separate days:
 - Marion: 18 separate days
 - Tippecanoe: 11 separate days
 - Vigo: 10 separate days

Executive Summary (AFL-CIO)

- ▶ The AFL-CIO Scale was presented for 1330 projects, and was adopted 1141 times (82.26% of total projects)
- ▶ The AFL-CIO Scale was presented in 585 hearings, and was adopted 506 times (83.91% of total hearings)

Executive Summary (ABC)

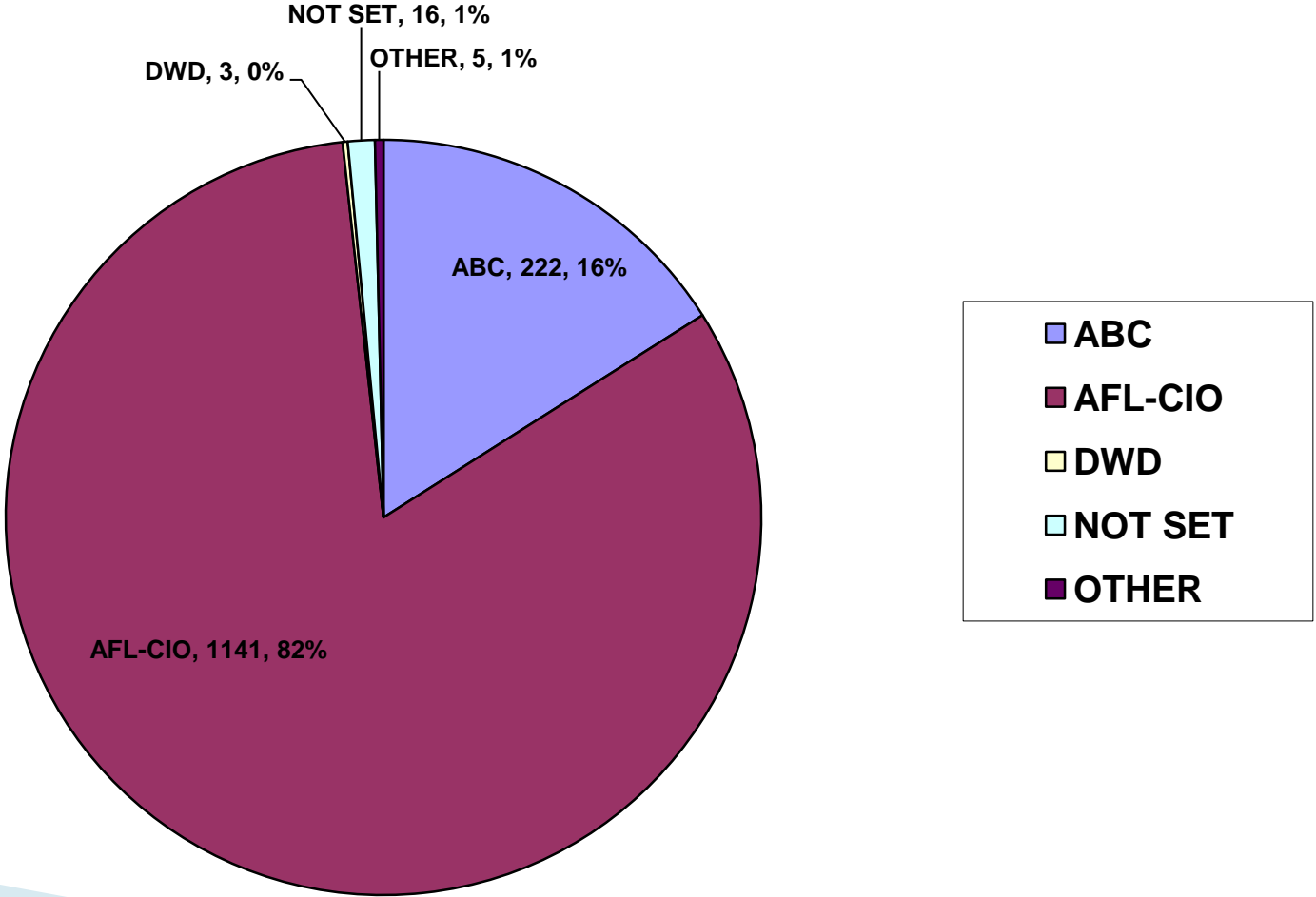
- ▶ The Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) Scale was presented for 301 projects, and was adopted 222 times (16.01% of total projects)
- ▶ The ABC Scale was presented in 183 hearings, and was adopted 83 times (13.76% of total hearings)

Executive Summary (DWD & “OTHER”)

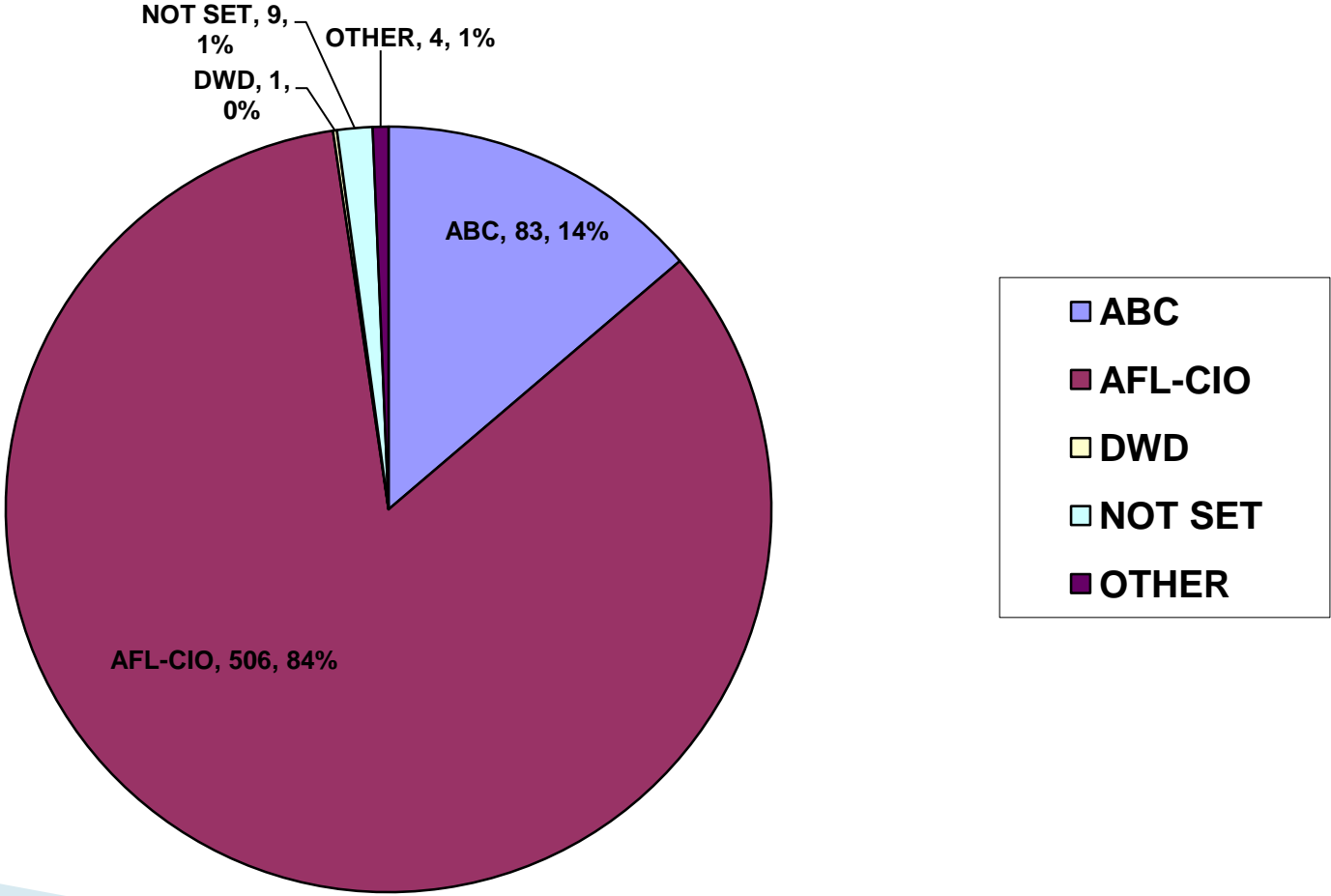
- ▶ Reports from the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) were adopted for 3 projects (.22% of total projects) in 1 hearing (.17% of total hearings)*
- ▶ “Other” scales were adopted for 5 projects (.36% of total projects) in 4 hearings (.66% of total hearings)

* In April 2010, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) issued a report that, by statute, must be considered by a Common Construction Wage committee. This new report is purely informational and it is not intended to be adopted as a wage scale.

Distribution of Scale Adoptions by Total Projects Statewide




Distribution of Scale Adoptions by Total Hearings Statewide


