**ALL APPRENTICES** - As approved by the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of Apprenticeship & Training.

The Wage rates under columns of **WAGES** and **FRINGES** are the minimum wage rates to be paid and shall not prevent the employer from paying a higher wage rate.

Stipulation as to the employment of apprentices as semiskilled: Apprentices will be permitted to work at the semiskilled rate for the classification of work they perform when they are employed pursuant to and individually registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship Training. Their wage rate will be their individual warranted percentage of the herein listed skilled classification common construction wage rate. Apprentices shall be permitted to work only at the ratio to journeymen as the apprenticeship program standards state.

The absence of a wage determination for the classes of unskilled workers in a particular classification is the result of the committee's determination that the common practice in the immediate locality is not to use unskilled workers in that classification on construction sites.
