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HIGHWAY AGREEMENT:

SHALL INCLUDE CONSTRUCTION, MODIFICATIONS, ADDITIONS OR REPAIRS OF ALL BRIDGES, ROADS AND STREET. ALSO CONSTRUCTION INCIDENTAL THERETO: ALLEYS, GUARD RAILS, FENCES, PARKWAYS, PARKING LOTS AND PARKING AREAS: REST PARKS, AIRPORTS, GRADING ATHLETIC FIELDS, HIGHWAY BRIDGES, SEWAGE AND WATERWORKS IMPROVEMENTS INCIDENTAL TO STREET AND HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION SITE PREPARATIONS TO BUILDING WORK.

THE WAGE RATES AS SET FORTH BY THE COMMITTEE ARE THE MINIMUM AND SHALL NOT PREVENT THE CONTRACTOR OR SUB-CONTRACTOR FROM PAYING A HIGHER RATE OF PAY.

THE WAGE RATES ARE ESTABLISHED ON THE DATE SIGNED, HOWEVER, IF THE PROJECT IS NOT AWARDED WITHIN 180 DAYS A NEW UPDATED WAGE RATE SHALL BE REQUIRED.

STIPULATION AS TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF APPRENTICES: APPRENTICES WILL BE PERMITTED TO WORK AT LESS THAN THE PREDETERMINED RATE FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF WORK THEY PERFORM WHEN THEY ARE EMPLOYED PURSUANT TO AND INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED IN A BONA FIDE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM REGISTERED WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, BUREAU OF APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING. THEIR WAGE RATE WILL BE THEIR INDIVIDUAL WARRANTED PERCENTAGE OF THE HEREIN LISTED SKILLED CLASSIFICATION COMMON WAGE RATE. APPRENTICESHIP SHALL BE PERMITTED TO WORK ONLY AS THE RATIO TO JOURNEYMEN IN THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM STANDARDS STATE.


THE ABSENCE OF A WAGE DETERMINATION FOR THE CLASSES OF SEMI-SKILLED AND UNSKILLED WORKERS IN A PARTICULAR CLASSIFICATION IS THE RESULT OF THE COMMITTEE'S DETERMINATION THAT THE COMMON PRACTICE IN THE IMMEDIATE LOCALITY IS NOT TO USE SEMI-SKILLED OR UNSKILLED WORKERS IN THAT CLASSIFICATION ON CONSTRUCTION SITES.

The wage rates are established on the date signed, however, if the project is not awarded within 180 days, a new updated wage rate shall be required.

Stipulation as to the employment of apprentices: Apprentices will be permitted to work at less than the predetermined rate for the classification of work they perform when they are employed pursuant to and individually registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the U.S. Department of labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training. Their wage rate will be their individual warranted percentage of the herein listed skilled classification common wage rate. Apprentices shall be permitted to work only as the ratio to journeymen in the apprenticeship program standards state.

The absence of wage determination for the classes of Semi-Skilled and Unskilled workers in a particular classification is the result of the committee's determination that the common practice in the immediate locality is not to use unskilled workers in that classification on construction sites.




REPRESENTING THE GOVERNOR OF INDIANA
