S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training. Their wage rate will be their individual warranted percentage of the herein listed skilled classification prevailing wage rate. Apprentices shall be permitted to work as the ratio to journeymen in the apprenticeship program standards state.
