
**STIPULATION AS TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF APPRENTICES:**

Apprentices are permitted to work at less than the predetermined rate for the classification of work they perform when they are employed pursuant to and individually registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training.


Their wage rate will be their individually warranted percentage for the classification of work they perform. Apprentices shall be permitted to work only as the ration of Apprentice to Journey worker as spelled out in their apprentice program standards.


