ADDENDA TO THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DRAWINGS

Item 1: Insert the attached "Common Construction Wage Scale", dated October 9, 2012, into the Project Manual Contract Requirements. This Wage Scale shall apply to all work included within the scope of the 2012 Road Resurfacing Project.

Item 2: At the Project Manual, add Alternate Bid #1 for crushed stone shoulder treatment along the segment of County Road 900 East proposed for re-surfacing.

At "SPECIAL PROVISIONS – 2012 STREET RESURFACING", add the following sections:

Part 3.06 STONE SHOULDER

Stone shoulder width shall be 2'-0" and the average compacted depth of stone shall be four (4) inches. Stone shoulder material shall be #53 crushed stone. Stone shoulder shall be roller compacted.

Under Part 4.02 METHOD OF PAYMENT, add Item 4 as follows:

Item 4 – Stone Shoulder: The unit price as specified to be paid for stone shoulder includes furnishing and installing specified stone shoulder material.

All labor, material, equipment and traffic control necessary for installation of stone shoulder shall be included in the unit price. The linear feet of stone shoulder shall be measured for payment. The unit price for stone shoulder shall be per linear foot of stone shoulder installed. This only applies to C.R. 900 East.

At Itemized Bid Proposal, add the attached second page "ITEMIZED BID PROPOSAL – ALTERNATE BID NO. 1".
