WAGE RATES

The wage rates under the column "Total Hourly Wage Rate" as set forth by the committee are the minimum wage rates to be paid and shall not prevent a contractor from paying a higher wage rate.

Skilled: An individual who performs work in a classification listed on the scale of wages. It shall be presumed that an employee is a skilled worker in that classification, and entitled to receive compensation at the skilled rate, unless the worker satisfies all of the criteria for being categorized as a semi-skilled or unskilled worker.

Semi-skilled: An individual registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program registered with the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training

Unskilled: An individual with less than twelve months of cumulative experience in the construction trades and who is not registered in a bona fide apprenticeship program

The above definitions shall not apply to workers in the classification of Laborer.


APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS:

The Wage Committee determines that the common practice in the county is for contractors to participate in bona fide apprenticeship programs registered with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training and that the rate of pay for the classifications of labor that participate in such programs is based in part on a percentage of the journeyman's rate (skilled rate herein) depending on the individual's progress in the program.


Workers engaged in such an apprenticeship program will be permitted to be paid the semi-skilled rate established in this wage determination

Disputes regarding the appropriate classification of workers and the amounts said workers should be paid may be submitted to the Indiana Department of Labor for investigation.



A Common Construction Wage Committee meeting was held this morning at 11:00 am as advertised in the 3rd floor conference room of the Adams County Service Complex, 313 W Jefferson St., Decatur, IN 46733 for 2 public works projects anticipated to be awarded by the City of Decatur within the next 90 days. Committee members, Tim Barkey, Dan Rickord, Nate Rumschlag and Glenn Head were present. The ABC representative, Felisha Minnich, indicated this morning by email that she would not be attending. Also present was Phyllis J. Whitright, Decatur Clerk-Treasurer, who kept the minutes of the meeting and Timothy E. Baker, Decatur City Attorney. Tim Barkey was unanimously elected chairperson of the Committee. Delivery and posting of Notice as required by the Indiana Open Door Law was certified in writing by Ms. Whitright, which certification was made a matter of record.

Although not in attendance, Ms. Minnich did deliver by email the ABC wage rate which was made a matter of record and considered by the Committee. In addition, the AFL-CIO wage rate along with supporting documentation was presented by Glenn Head, the AFL-CIO representative, which information was also made a matter of record and considered by the Committee. After a full discussion, Mr. Head moved to adopt the AFL-CIO wage scale presented as the common construction wage for the upcoming Decatur projects. The motion was seconded by Nate Rumschlag and was unanimously adopted by the Committee. A faxed copy of same is provided. Upon receipt of the typed minutes kept by Ms. Whitright, a copy of same will also be forwarded to you for your information and appropriate action.
