MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE COMMON CONSTRUCTION WAGE COMMITTEE FOR THE DECATUR COUNTY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

A meeting of the Common Construction Wage Committee for the Decatur County Community Schools construction project was held in the Greensburg Public Library, Conference Room, 1110 East Main Street, Greensburg, Indiana, on July 23, 2014, at the hour of 9:00 a.m. (Local Time), pursuant to notice duly given in accordance with I.C. 5-14-1.5.

The meeting was called to order by Douglas C. Wilson of Decatur County Schools..

On call of the roll, the members of the Committee were shown to be present or absent as follows: Present: Mark Mohr, Don Lewellyn, Brad Speer, Michael Hardy

Absent: Representative of Associated Builders and Contractors Therefore a quorum was declared for the transaction of business.

Douglas C. Wilson, presided over the meeting and welcomed the committee members.
