**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE COMMON CONSTRUCTION WAGE

A meeting of the Common Construction Wage Committee for the Decatur County Community Schools construction project was held in the Greensburg Public Library, Conference Room, 1110 East Main Street, Greensburg, Indiana, on July 23, 2014, at the hour of 9:00 a.m. (Local Time), pursuant to notice duly given in accordance with I.C. 5-14-1.5.

The meeting was called to order by Douglas C. Wilson of Decatur County Schools..

On call of the roll, the members of the Committee were shown to be present or absent as follows: **Present:** Mark Mohr, Don Lewellyn, Brad Speer, Michael Hardy

**Absent:** Representative of Associated Builders and Contractors

Therefore a quorum was declared for the transaction of business.

Douglas C. Wilson, presided over the meeting and welcomed the committee members. He explained that the purpose of the meeting was that under Indiana Code 5-16-7, a Common Construction Wage Committee must establish the common construction wage for Decatur County for the Decatur County Community Schools construction project consisting of both the South Decatur and North Decatur High Schools Fieldhouse's (the "Project").

Mr. Wilson stated that the first order of business was the discussion of the common construction wage in Decatur County. Evidence was presented by Michael Hardy of the AFL-CIO as to what the common wages are for the classes and classifications of workers that may be required for the construction contemplated for the "Project" for Decatur County Schools. Mr. Wilson then presented evidence as to what the common wages are for the classes and classifications of workers that may be required for the construction contemplated for the "Project" for Decatur County Schools. That had been provided to him by the Associated Builders and Contractors of Indiana. After the presentation of wage information and discussion upon a motion duly made, seconded and approved the Committee voted to adopt the attached scale (including fringe benefits) as the Common Construction Wages for the Project.
