#### **Biography**

David Lewis is the Vice President-Global Taxes, Chief Tax Executive and Assistant Treasurer at Eli Lilly and Company. Lewis has global responsibility for all aspects of the Company's tax-related matters including strategy & planning, tax & economic policy, project execution, tax accounting & compliance, and tax audits & dispute resolution. Previously, Lewis engaged in the private practice of law, focusing primarily in the areas of taxation, securities, banking and corporate law.

Lewis graduated from Wabash College in 1981 with an Economics degree, and from the Indiana University School of Law in Bloomington in 1984. Lewis has specific expertise in U.S. federal tax policy including international taxation, as well as matters related to state and local fiscal and tax policy. Lewis currently serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors of The Tax Foundation, as well as Chairman of both the PhRMA Tax Committee and the Executive/Finance Committee of The Tax Council. He also serves on the Board of Directors of The Tax Council, the Tax Council Policy Institute, the Indy Partnership and the Indiana Fiscal Policy Institute. He served as Co-Chair of the Tax & Fiscal Study Commission of Indiana University Public Policy Institute's Policy Choices for Indiana's Future initiative and currently serves on this institute's Board of Advisors. He also is actively involved in tax reform efforts in Washington, D.C., including serving on the Board of Directors of the Alliance for Competitive Taxation.

Lewis is a frequent guest lecturer in tax and fiscal matters at the federal, state and local governmental levels, and has authored several articles on tax law in the international marketplace. He is also a frequent lecturer on the behaviors of business partnering within tax, financial and business organizations.
