

SYNTHETIC DRUG COMMUNITY PROTECTION AGREEMENT

The undersigned Indiana retailer agrees and acknowledges that:

- Synthetic drugs (as defined in Ind. Code § 35-41-1-26.3) which are often marked and marketed as “K2”, “Spice”, “Incense”, “Potpourri”, “Herbal Sachets”, “Plant Food”, or “Bath Salts” contain dangerous chemicals that are harmful to the residents of Indiana.
- I will immediately cease selling synthetic drugs and will not in the future sell synthetic drug products regardless of the representations made by those who manufacture, distribute and/or supply these drug products to Indiana retailers.
- I understand and acknowledge that the distribution of synthetic drug products violates the Indiana Uniform Food Drug and Cosmetics Act, Ind. Code § 16-42-1-1, *et seq.*, and Indiana Deceptive Consumer Sales Act, Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-1, *et seq.*, and may contain controlled substances or their analogs, in violation of the Indiana Controlled Substances Act, Ind. Code § 35-48-1-1, *et seq.* and applicable federal law.
- I voluntarily relinquish my entire inventory of synthetic drug products to the Drug Enforcement Administration, Indiana Attorney General’s Office, or coordinating Indiana law enforcement agency and authorize the destruction of these products.
- If applicable, I enter into this agreement with the understanding that execution of and compliance with this agreement will result in the closure of any pending investigation into these activities, so long as I remain in compliance.
- I acknowledge that if I commence or resume selling synthetic drug products or possessing synthetic drug products with the intent to deliver them, this agreement will be used to establish my knowledge of and intent to violate applicable Indiana and federal law.
- This agreement will be maintained by the Indiana Attorney General’s Office and will be shared with state and federal prosecutors and law enforcement agencies upon request.
