



PREPAID WIRELESS FEE – EFFECTIVE JULY 1

Effective July 1, 2010, all retail merchants in Indiana that sell prepaid wireless telephone services (through the sale of a prepaid phone or prepaid phone card) must collect a fee of \$.25 per sales transaction. This new law also requires retail merchants to notify customers of this new fee.

The fee, known as the Prepaid 911 Enhancement Fee, will ensure Indiana complies with 911 requirements set down by the Indiana General Assembly. This is the result of a new Indiana law (IC 36-8-16.6-14) passed during the 2010 legislative session.
