#	Question	INDOT Response
1.	2. Proposer and Team Structure and Experience states, "Proposers shall provide the following information, not to exceed five (5) pages..." Within the 5 page limitation, is the intent to include 2.1 to 2.3 information, and a separate 3 pages dedicated to 2.4 Relevant Experience. Please Confirm.	See revisions to Part B, Section 2. Proposer's response to Part B, Sections 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3 shall not exceed five (5) pages. Proposer's response to Part B, Section 2.4 shall not exceed three (3) pages.
2.	Please provide forms in Word format.	INDOT will provide Word versions of the required Forms on the Project website.
3.	In the descriptions of the scope of work in Section A, Section C and Section D under paragraph (a), the scope of the work refers to "resurfacing" of the existing lanes. Since the scope of the work plays a large part in the teaming, please clarify that unlike other I-65 Added Travel Lanes projects where reconstruction was mandated this project will involve only resurfacing of existing and no responsibility for it's condition.	INDOT anticipates that resurfacing will account for a majority of the existing travel lanes work; however ongoing pavement assessment continues and will be further defined in the Draft and Final RFP.
4.	Indicates the page limit is 5 pages; Page B-3, Section 2.4 the page limit for relevant projects is 3 pages. Does this mean we have 8 total pages for Section 2 or are we limited to 2 pages for Proposer and Team Structure + 3 pages for Relevant Experience = 5 pages total for Section 2	See revisions to Part B, Section 2. Proposer's response to Part B, Sections 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3 shall not exceed five (5) pages. Proposer's response to Part B, Section 2.4 shall not exceed three (3) pages.
5.	Can we assume that any legal discussions do not apply to the page limits set in the previous question and pages shall be provided as needed for legal discussions?	There are no maximum page limit requirements for Proposer's response to information required in Part B, Section 2.6.
