


- ① FULL-ACCESS CONTROL LINE SHOULD EXTEND ALONG THE CROSS ROAD BEYOND THE RAMP TERMINAL TAPER EXTREMITY (BOTH SIDES OF ROAD) 100' TO 200' IN URBAN AREAS AND 300' TO 500' IN RURAL AREAS. THE END OF ACCESS CONTROL SHOULD BE AT OPPOSITE POINTS, WHERE FEASIBLE.
- ② IN CASE I and II THE AUXILIARY LANE TERMINATING THE GREATER DISTANCE FROM THE INTERCHANGE AREA SHOULD GOVERN.
