

102-C-145 TOLL ROAD SPECIAL PROVISIONS

CONTACT FOR QUESTIONS REGARDING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 102, AFTER LINE 22, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

102.03 Contact for Questions Regarding Contract Documents

If apparent errors, discrepancies, or unclear statements are found in the contract documents, Project Engineer for the Toll Road, Randy Allen shall be contacted by telephone, (574) 674-8836, or by fax, (574) 675-0286.

HAZARD COMMUNICATION PROGRAM

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 106, AFTER LINE 219, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the requirements of OSHA the bidder shall inform its employees concerning the health and safety hazards of chemical substances that may be required in the performance of the contract work. The bidder shall complete and sign the form included in the Proposal Book and submit the completed form with the bid.

TOLL ROAD PASSES

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 107, AFTER LINE 101, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

The Indiana Toll Road Division (ITR) will issue non-revenue passes to the Contractor and its subcontractors as needed to perform the work on this contract. The Contractor shall be responsible for correct use of the passes by its workers and subcontractors. Improper use of the Toll Road by Contractor's employees who do not have valid passes will be strictly prohibited. The passes shall be obtained from the Project Engineer, or other designated representative, Fax No. 574-675-0286.

CONTRACTOR'S VEHICLES & PERSONAL VEHICLES

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 107, BEGIN LINE 265, DELETE AND INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

public and residents as is considered unavoidable. Non-operating construction equipment, ~~worker's vehicles~~, and materials, ~~field offices, field laboratories, and temporary offices~~ may be stored on the right-of-way no less than 30 ft (9m) from the edge of pavement lanes open to

SECTION 107, AFTER LINE 288, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

All vehicles and equipment used in connection with or by the Contractor or any of its subcontractors on the job site shall be marked with the Contractor's or

subcontractor's company name. All vehicles and equipment used on the Indiana Toll Road, County Road or State Highway right-of-ways, shall have all lights and equipment in good working condition. All vehicles that enter or cross traffic areas shall be equipped with an operating warning light or lights, which are visible from all directions. The warning lights shall meet or exceed the requirements of 801.14(d).

No privately owned vehicles will be allowed on the Indiana Toll Road mainline. The Contractor shall provide transportation of workmen to and from its staging area to work sites. Workmen's vehicles may be parked on structures carrying local roads over the Toll Road or outside of toll plazas provided that such parking does not create a hazard to passing traffic.

HOLIDAYS

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 108, AFTER LINE 328, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

Only construction activities, which are approved by the Engineer, will be allowed on holidays. Deliveries and activities on holidays which cause construction equipment to cross lanes on the Toll Road will be strictly prohibited.

PARTIAL PAYMENTS

The Standard Specifications are revised as follows:

SECTION 109, DELETE LINES 662 THROUGH 665.

SECTION 109, AFTER LINE 666, INSERT AS FOLLOWS:

From the total of the amounts ascertained as payable an amount equivalent to no less than 5% of the whole will be deducted and retained by the Department until after substantial completion of the entire contract in an acceptable manner, except as set out in 105 IAC 11-3-8 of the Rules For Prequalification of Contractors And Bidding. The balance, or an amount not to exceed 95% of the whole less all previous payments and less amounts claimed which are required to be held by the Department in accordance with Indiana Code 8-23-9-26 through 8-23-9-39, will be certified for payment.
