Sen. Sue Landske: Third Annual Hoosier Women Veterans' Conference set in October

Resources will be available to Indiana's more than 33,000 female military veterans

STATEHOUSE (Sept. 9, 2009) - Indiana's Third Annual Hoosier Women Veterans' Conference will be held Saturday, Oct. 31 at the Indiana War Memorial, 431 North Meridian St., Indianapolis, State Sen. Sue Landske (R-Cedar Lake) said.

Landske, a retired colonel in the National Guard Reserves, said the event is open to all women who have served in the military.

"This free event provides Hoosier women who have served in the military the opportunity to connect and relate to other women who have shared similar experiences," Landske said. "Helpful information about the numerous resources, opportunities and benefits available to women who have served and are serving in the military will be provided at the conference."

Registration for the event begins at 8 a.m. and is hosted by the Indiana Department of Veterans Affairs, the Federal Department of Veterans Affairs and the Richard L. Roudebush - Fort Wayne and Marion VA Medical Centers.

Landske said attendees will be provided lunch at the event that begins at 9 a.m. and ends at 3 p.m.

Indiana, as of 2007, had an estimated 33,000 women veterans and 2,200 women on active duty (not including the National Guard), according to the Indiana Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Sen. Landske represents Senate District 6, which includes Benton, Lake, Newton and Porter counties.
