Questions

Are there a minimum number of clients to be served?

No, there are no a minimum numbers, but the amount served should be adjusted based on the amount of funding received.

Could a course have ABE ESL students and EL/ Civics students?

Yes, but it must include all four of the civics requirements required by Congress, the workplace component, and all other requirements as stated in the RFA. The grantee must also determine which students will be counted for EL/ Civics.

Can I count EL/ Civics students with the ABE continuation grant?

No, you “cannot double dip”. You must determine in your grant application which students will count toward EL/ Civics for performance. If projections exceed funding levels to support EL/Civics students, then the ABE continuation grant may cover additional students.

Do you have to have the same fiscal agent as the ABE grant?

No, you can have a different fiscal agent for each grant.
