Preliminary PY12 Outcomes

29,250

- Student Enrollment
- Slight Increase over PY11

22,689

- Level Gains (student may have achieved more than one gain)
- 22% increase over PY11

6,773

- GEDs and HS Diplomas Awarded
- 19% increase over PY11

\$973

- Cost per student who attained a level gain (equivalent to two K-12 grade levels)

646

- WorkINdiana Enrollments in PY12
- 54% increase over PY11
- Of those who exited since inception, 81% completion rate

GED Closeout Campaign

- Roughly 5000 individuals being targeted through letter campaign
- GED Closeout Campaign Flyer to utilize locally
- Interested individuals can call a 1-800 number and talk to DWD customer service staff about nearest adult education class location



WorkINdiana Enrollments by Region as of June 30, 2013




InTERS Updates


