
Why Numbers Matter

WorkINdiana Enrollments

(Minus Marion County)



204 Enrollments PY11-12 PY12-13 60 Enrollments

- 264 Enrollments
- 163 Completions (62%)
- 118 Earned Certifications (72%)
- 66 Found Jobs (56%)

WorkINdiana – Next Steps

- Strengthen WorkINdiana Program
 - 5% of adult education enrollments (@1,000)
- Remove Barriers
- Revise Statement of Work

InTERS Updates

- InTERS training available :
 - Remaining dates: 11/16, 19, 21, 27, 28
 - Topics include: student views (duplicate enrollments, etc.), cleaning test errors, NRS table clean up, reading the reimbursement report, metrics reports, message board and intro for new custom reports feature
- New feature to prevent duplicates
- Metrics report availability now by: Statewide, region, program

Accuplacer Update

- DWD Adult Education institutional account
 - Adult education programs manage their own sites
 - Responsible for assessment costs (utilize Innovation fund)
 - Access to all student data
 - Will match automatically to InTERS
 - Accuplacer Placement vs. Diagnostic
 - Placement determines transition to post-secondary
 - Diagnostic determines strengths/weaknesses for MyFoundationsLab remediation

Accuplacer Update

– Pricing

- Placement = \$1.55 per testing unit. Test is adaptive—a maximum of 4 units per student (\$6.20).
- Diagnostic=\$15 for 10 weeks of access per student (subject to change as determined by vendor)
