DWD and WIOA Updates

- New Commissioner begins in late November
- DOL Town Hall Debrief from October 15th
- Joint meeting with Youth Coordinators on November 5th
- New WIOA Policy Director

Policy Updates

- **Assessment Policy**
 - Annual review by USDOE
 - No longer allowable to combine TABE Survey and Complete Battery in pre- and post-testing.
- **Performance Incentives TAB**
 - Employment Incentive redefined to align more closely with NRS Table 5
 - Alignment with latest Accuplacer cut scores

HSE Updates

- 2014 scores will carry into 2015
- CTB/MH has set up new screening to catch anomalous scores:
 - Selecting the same answer choice for more than 50% of questions; and
 - Scoring two standard deviations above the hypothetical score; and
 - Number of correct responses is less than 7 above the cut score

TABE Updates

- New order forms on the website:

- Assessment policy change is being required by US DOE:
 - Students must post test using the same version of the test (Complete Battery vs. Survey) as was used for the pre test.
 - Both versions of the test will continue to be available to our sites.

Designing Contextualized Instruction

Designing Contextualized Instruction helps teachers understand contextualized instruction and its supporting research base and discover how to use the contextual model of instruction to develop Adult Career Pathways (ACP) courses, and how to identify and overcome common challenges in developing contextualized instruction. The course is self-paced and features three modules: (1) Understanding Contextualized Instruction; (2) Building Contextualized Lessons; and (3) Overcoming Development Challenges.

Engaging Adult Learners in Science

This course provides an overview of the relevance and importance of science in the adult basic education/adult secondary education (ABE/ASE) classroom and introduces the use of scientific practices in the ABE/ASE classroom.

Professional Development Updates

Formative Assessment to Inform Quality Adult ESL Instruction

This course offers a review of effective ways to use meaningful, formative assessments and useful tools and processes for guiding instruction. Topics include: An overview of formative assessment in language teaching; Assessment activities to engage learners and help them monitor their progress; Oral and written feedback techniques

Learning 2 Achieve: Learning Disabilities and Neuroscience

This course presents information on the brain and brain functions to provide understanding of learning disabilities. You will learn about the human brain, cognitive neuroscience and research.


