Integrating Career Awareness (ICA) Study Circle:

This six-week, online learning and discussion group offered through LINCS in conjunction with WorldEd will prepare instructors and counselors to implement the [Integrating Career Awareness into the ABE & ESOL Classroom \(ICA\) Curriculum Guide](#), a set of lesson plans and activities designed to help adult students understand and act on the critical link between education and careers.

This study circle will be delivered in three sessions, scaffolding from session to session. Each session is approximately 1.5 hours long, with 2 hours of participant activity assignments in between. The three sessions are:

- Session #1: The How and Why of Career Planning
 - Session #2: Exploring Career Planning Resources
 - Session #3: Tying it all Together: Career Planning Skills
- **Study Circle will run from May – June**


