Proposed Regs for IE&T

- Balance proportion of instruction across elements of adult ed & literacy activities, workforce preparation, and training
- Deliver components simultaneously
- Use occupationally relevant materials and develop a single set of learning objectives across the 3 components

Proposed Regs

Educational and Career Advancement

1. Programs can demonstrate educational component is aligned with state's content standards for AE under the state's unified plan
2. Program is part of a career pathway as defined in WIOA

Proposed Regs

Programs lead to attainment of HSE, transition to postsecondary education or employment by

1. Using rigorous AE standards that meet those standards in unified plan
2. Providing supportive services to attain HSE, transition to postsecondary education/training
3. Designing program as part of pathway

Proposed Regs

How prospective AE providers can demonstrate their effectiveness

- Providing performance data, specifically data on its record on improving skills of low literacy individuals and outcomes in employment, HSE attainment, transition to postsecondary education/training

Proposed Regs

- DWD requests:

- Offer feedback to DWD on how we might interpret the regulations.

Household Income & Family Size:

Helps:

- Programs to understand who students are, barriers they face, and supports/interventions best suited to meet their needs.
- Programs tell “the story” of their program for grants (both DWD AE and other funding sources) demonstrating both needs and giving a clearer picture of success.
- DWD when applying for non-WIOA grants/funding.

Future Data Projects:

- Comparing income to retention, gains/time to gain, and transitions





WorkINdiana Survey Results


Do you know which career pathways are offered in your region?


