OCTAE Updates

- 2014 State Directors' Meeting:

Making Skills Everyone's Business Action Plan

- Joint ownership of solutions
- Expand opportunities for adults to improve foundation skills
- Make career pathways available in every community
- Ensure all students have access to highly effective teachers, leaders and programs
- Align federal policies and programs to integrate services for adults
- Increase the ROI in skills training for business, industry, and labor
- Commit to closing the equity gap for vulnerable subpopulations

OCTAE Updates

- Moving Pathways Forward: Supporting Career Pathways Integration
 - Indiana is a part of this project and on the same team as Wisconsin and New Jersey
 - Focus on developing interagency support and infrastructure for developing career pathways for all adults beyond WorkINdiana
 - 2-year project—our team will report out to and engage the field as the project gets underway.

OCTAE Updates

- WIA Incentive Grant for PY2011 Performance
 - WIA Title I Adult and Youth performance measures were met
 - WIA Title II performance measures were met (Table 4)
 - \$1.13 million in funding over a 2-year period
 - Currently, DWD's lead team and CECI staff are coordinating efforts to determine how to leverage these grant funds to serve the widest population possible.
 - Deadline for submission of the grant application is May 30th.

HSE Test Operations

- Over 1600 testers! 69% passing rate
- Diplomas are being mailed to those who have passed the HSE assessment!
- Data in the Registration System not matching the data on the demographic section of the answer sheet major cause of the delay.
 - May result in up to a 4 week delay in student information being viewable on DiplomaSender.com.
 - Either the UUID or SSN can be used on DiplomaSender.com.

HSE Test Operations

- Release of two TABS on HSE Operations: monitoring and new sites
- 1st Q enrollment of new testing sites is complete.
 - There is now a testing center within 30 miles of nearly every Hoosier.
 - Efforts moving forward will be focused on setting up additional sites in the areas most in need.
- On the Reference Sheet for the Math test the formula for volume of a pyramid is $V=1/3Bh$
 - B means area of the base.

InTERS Updates

- All areas of InTERS have been updated to HSE and we will be data matching the first HSE files this week
- New report-Previous test form/level shows when to test in subject areas outside of the focus subject
- New report-Students Requiring Remediation shows what students need to take Accuplacer test again to receive Transition to PS incentive payment
- User accounts not active within 6 months will be deactivated-will need to call and let us know if you need it reactivated
- Inactive check box is now listed on student record general screen only
- Adding new site program record-do not check carryover demographics if student already has a site program record in the term
- ABE Letter Writer section is available for use
- ABE contacts document will be released soon to provide the field with contact information for each program

PY 13-14 Grant Closeouts

- Grant close out packages will be sent out the first week of July -- Please return as quickly as possible.
- Final reimbursement for expenses through June 30th due before you turn in the grant closeout.
 - NOTE: Funds end on June 30. Only ACTUAL expenses through June 30th will be reimbursed. Disallowed costs last year for expenses that occurred after July 1.




