

Assessment Updates

- HSE passing rates released for 2015 version of TASC
 - The volume of test-takers for the first two months was relatively low
 - As expected, with the increased rigor of the test, rates diminished within the scope previously determined
 - Indiana continues to surpass the national averages for TASC in all areas





WorkINDiana Survey Results


Is there any professional development that you would like in order to help you carry out your role (specifically for WorkINDiana)?


