# Performance Incentive Schedule Change

Employment Incentive definition change aligns with “Entered Employment” on T5:

**Was:**

**Time Start:** The first calendar day after earning the HSE or upon exit if entered with HSE or diploma

**Time Stop:** Student must enter employment Student must enter employment, a formal apprenticeship program or military or student must retain employment if already employed, within 90 days of exiting the program.

**Now:**

**Time Start:** The first calendar day after exit

**Time Stop:** Student must be “seeking employment” at entry and must enter employment, a formal apprenticeship program or military within 90 days of exiting the program.


