
Job-seeking Veterans: Make your move to WorkOne

If you are an armed forces veteran in search of employment opportunities, then make your move to your local WorkOne center. Indiana is committed to providing quality employment services to veterans through its WorkOne Centers. These services provide veterans with the necessary information they need to find and secure suitable employment and make the transition from the military to the civilian workforce.

The Veteran Service program provides employment services, including job placement, to qualified veterans. To qualify for employment services you must meet one of the following definitions and be registered with your local WorkOne Center.

- Any individual who served more than 180 days on active duty (not for Reserve or National Guard training).
- Any individual who served on active duty and was released because of a service connected illness or injury. (Does not have to meet the 180-day rule)
- Any individual who was in the National Guard or Reserves and was called to active duty during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge is authorized. (Examples are Panama, Grenada, Haiti, Beruit, Persian Gulf, Desert Shield or Desert Storm. You do not have to have served in that area.)

In addition to other knowledgeable staff at your local WorkOne Center, local offices have on-site Veteran Representatives that can assist you with a variety of veteran related issues. Ask to see your Local Veteran Employment Representative (LVER), or Disabled Veteran Outreach Program Specialist (DVOP), today.

Employment services that are provided to qualified veterans include:

- Registration in the state's Job Matching System.
- Orientation Services.
- Job search workshops including, assistance in preparing resumes, cover letters, and preparation for interviews.
- Job search material such as booklets, videos and pamphlets.
- Referrals to supportive services.
- Information on the Veteran's rights and employment benefits.
- Case Management for veterans needing intensive services to overcome barriers to employment.
- Veteran's preference on all matching for jobs.
- Assessment using WorkKeys for Profiled jobs.
- Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) certification.
- Vocational guidance.
- Up-to-date Labor Market Information (LMI).
- Direct referral to jobs.
- Aptitude and Interest testing.
- Follow-up after job placement.
