- WorkEthic is a certificate program for high school juniors and seniors who demonstrate the WorkEthic standards.
- WorkEthic strives to develop skills in high school students that will drive success in higher education and the workplace.

- Certification provides students with tangible support for job interviews, resumes and college applications.

- Students who meet the minimum point requirement in all ten of the following criterion will be awarded a WorkEthic certificate.
 - Organization
 - Teamwork
 - Punctuality
 - Absence
 - Community Service or Internship Project
 - Respectfulness
 - Discipline
 - Attendance
 - Tardy
 - Overall GPA
