Program Year 2006 Workforce Investment Act Title I Adult,  
Dislocated Worker and Youth Formula Allocations

**Purpose**

To announce the Program Year 2006 Workforce Investment Act Title I Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth formula allocations

**Rescissions**

**Content**

The Indiana Department of Workforce Development is announcing planning estimates for Workforce Investment Act Title I adult and youth formula allocations to workforce investment boards and regional workforce boards. Final formula allocations are also being released for Workforce Investment Act Title I dislocated worker funding. Please see the attached chart.

Final adult and youth allocations will not be released until after the Program Year 2006 has begun. The Department of Labor discovered a problem with the methodology used by states to identify Areas of Substantial Unemployment. The problem significantly impacted state funding. Subsequently, states are identifying Areas of Substantial Unemployment again using the only data satisfactory to the Department of Labor, the 1990 Census data, albeit dated. Since revised Areas of Substantial Unemployment data were not available in time to release state adult and

youth allotments, states received amounts based on the minimum amounts they are guaranteed under the Workforce Investment Act formula minimum provisions. After states submit their revised Areas of Substantial Unemployment data and it has been certified, full formula allotments for the states will be calculated and announced. Eligible states will receive their remaining formula funds.

Complete information concerning the process used to formula allocate Workforce Investment Act funding can be found in the Indiana Department of Workforce Development's allocation policy for Program Year 2006. Indiana's allotments are provided:

- The adult planning allotment is \$13,083,086, of which \$11,120,623 was formula allocated.
- The youth planning allotment is \$15,166,794, of which \$12,891,775 was formula allocated.
- The dislocated worker final allotment is \$24,288,613, of which \$14,573,167 was formula allocated.

Final Workforce Investment Act adult and youth allocations are anticipated to be announced by the Department of Labor in late summer/early fall. The Indiana Department of Workforce Development will release the allocations shortly after they are published.
