

Re: WARN Act Notice of Plant Closing

Dear Mr. Hutchinson, Mr. Conklin, and Ms. Long:

In our letter dated June 10, 2016, we advised you that Applegate Livestock Equipment, Inc. had developed plans to close its facility located at 902 S. State Road 32, Union City, IN 47390. In that letter we noted that we expected employee separations to occur in phases between June 28, 2016 and July 12, 2016, with the shutdown expected to be complete by July 31 2016.

Due to recent changing business needs and proceedings with a potential buyer, we are informing you of our need for an extension. If the sale occurs, then Applegate understands that most employees will be offered continued employment with the new entity and therefore likely will not experience an employment loss under the WARN Act. If the sale does not occur, then Applegate will cease its operations and employment separations will be expected to occur between the dates of July 25, 2016 to August 5, 2016 with the complete facility shutdown expected by August 12, 2016.



In accordance with the terms of the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN Act"), please be advised that: all affected employees were notified of the potential sale and the planned extension.
