

Beyond the April 2016 Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana Private Sector jobs is now 32,400 above the March 2000 peak employment levels.
- Indiana's unemployment rate decrease of -5.6% from July, 2009, the low point of employment, ranks 9th in the U.S.
- Indiana's rate decrease of -3.2% since January 2013 ranks 12th in the nation.
- The Hoosier labor force has grown by 178,442 individuals since January 2013.
- Indiana's labor force has grown at 0.6% over the month, ranks 1st in the nation.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 23 months in a row. (Indiana's rate increased to 65.3% vs. 62.8% for national.)
- Indiana Private Sector grew by 0.5% over the month, which ranks 5th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has grown 21.5% since July 2009, the low point of employment, ranks 2nd in the nation.
