State Line Energy

Dear Mr. Kinder:

Dominion has had various communications with government officials about its plans for State Energy Station, and the company intends to continue those communications for the months to come. This letter provides the formal notice required by the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act.

State Line Energy Station is located at 103rd Street & Lake Michigan, Hammond, Indiana 46320. Dominion plans to close the entire State Line Energy Station plant, and the action is expected to be permanent.

Dominion currently employs approximately 109 persons at State Line Energy Station, in the job classifications listed in the enclosure to this letter. All of those employees will experience a permanent employment loss as a result of this plant closing, unless they obtain a position with Dominion at another location. The first employment losses are scheduled to occur on March 31, 2012. However, Dominion has provided all of the employees the opportunity to continue working at the power station, helping with the decommissioning of the station, for three additional months, until June 30, 2012. If an employee accepts this opportunity, then finds another job or decides for other reasons to resign before June 30, 2012, the employee must give Dominion two weeks' notice before resigning.


Thus, the expected dates of employment loss are as follows:

- For employees who do not accept the opportunity to work three additional months: March 31, 2012.
- For employees who accept the opportunity to work three additional months, but then resign during that period: between March 31, 2012 and June 30, 2012.
- For employees who accept the opportunity to work three additional months and remain employed throughout that period: June 30, 2012.

The United Steel, Paper and International Union, Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers, AFL-CIO-CLC, Local 12502, represents a bargaining unit of employees at the power station. The chief elected officer of Local 12502 is the President, David Weaver. Although the collective bargaining agreement with Local 12502 provides bumping rights in certain circumstances, Dominion does not anticipate that any such circumstances will arise in connection with this plant closing, and thus there do not appear to be any bumping rights applicable to this situation.
