**Re: Worker's Adjustment and Retraining Notification for
Fort Wayne Foundry Corp. – Machining Division**

Dear Sir or Madam:

Please be advised that I am the President of Fort Wayne Foundry Corporation. I am providing you this notice as required under the Worker's Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN").

Although we continue to look for other business opportunities to avoid this event, due to the severe downturn in the automotive industry, I regret to inform you that Fort Wayne Foundry Corporation has made the decision to conduct a mass layoff at its Machining Division located at 3404 Conestoga Drive in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

As a result, the employees currently employed at that facility, and listed below will be placed on layoff. Our best estimate is that the first employees to be laid off under this WARN notice will begin to occur on or about May 31, 2009, and likely continue through June 28, 2009.

We also, pursuant to WARN, provide you with the following list of job titles of the positions affected and the number of affected employees within each job classification:

Maintenance	Three (3)

Because this is a mass layoff at a unionized facility, bumping rights for the hourly employees affected will be followed, as required in the Collective Bargaining Agreement, to establish the actual sequence of eliminated jobs.
