Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** manufacturing makes a significant contribution to the national, state, and local economy; and
- WHEREAS,** manufacturing contributes over \$100 billion to Indiana's economy annually; and
- WHEREAS,** manufacturing accounts for 30 percent of the state's Gross Domestic Product; and
- WHEREAS,** Indiana leads the nation in the percentage of residents who work in the manufacturing industry, with over half a million manufacturing jobs in the state; and
- WHEREAS,** manufacturing contributes the most high wage jobs of any sector in Indiana's economy; and
- WHEREAS,** manufacturing companies in Indiana and around the nation are using the first week in October to address common misperceptions about, and to highlight the importance of, manufacturing; and
- WHEREAS,** many Indiana manufacturing businesses are, on October 7, 2016 opening their doors to host tours, to educate and inspire the next generation of manufacturers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael R. Pence, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim October 7, 2016 as

MANUFACTURING DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
