

Beyond the September 2015 Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana is now 9,200 Private Sector jobs above March 2000 peak employment levels.
- Indiana's unemployment rate decrease of -6.3% from July, 2009, the low point of employment, and -3.9% since January 2013 both rank 2nd in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate decrease of -1.3% over the past year ranks 4th in the U.S.
- The Hoosier labor force has grown by 84,000 individuals since January 2013, which leads the Midwest.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 24 months in a row. (Indiana's increased to 63.5% vs. 62.4%.)
- Hoosier Private Sector job growth of 6,600 in September ranked 4th in the nation.
- Private Sector job growth of 63,200 over the past year in Indiana ranks 9th in the U.S.
- Since July 2009, Indiana has added 298,600 Private Sector jobs, which ranks 12th in the nation. (+128,900 since January 2013, or +5.2%.)
- The Hoosier State has added the 2nd most Manufacturing jobs (+92,500) in the U.S. since July 2009, at a rate that ranks 3rd in the nation (+21.6%).
- Indiana has grown the 3rd most Manufacturing jobs in the U.S. over the past year (+10,800).
- Indiana continues to have the highest concentration of private sector Manufacturing jobs in the U.S.
- The Hoosier State ranked 6th in the nation in Private Educational & Health jobs added (+3,000) in September, and has added the 9th most over the past year (+14,900).
- Indiana has added 22,700 Trade, Transportation and Utilities jobs over the past year, which ranks 5th in the nation, at a rate of +3.9%, which ranks 2nd in the U.S.
- Construction growth in Indiana in September ranked 7th in the nation (+1,700), at a rate of 1.4%, which ranked 8th in the U.S.
