Dear Ms Long:

I wanted to let you know that today we met with the employees at our manufacturing operation located at 10801 Rose Avenue in New Haven, Indiana and announced that we will be closing this facility by June 30, 2016. This manufacturing facility is part of the Parker Hannifin Instrumentation Group and employs approximately 150 people. Our intent is to transfer manufacturing primarily to Parker Hannifin's Greenfield, TN operations with additional outsourcing as required.

We arrived at this difficult but necessary decision after careful consideration of alternatives. However, maintaining operations at this facility is simply not a viable option. Our proposed plan was necessary to reduce the fixed costs of our operations and improve our competitiveness globally. This action in no way reflects the performance of our dedicated employees at this facility. We can also appreciate the impact of this decision on the local community and we very much appreciate the contributions and support we have received here over the years.

You should know that we are committed to easing the transition for all our employees and our intent will be to provide severance pay, as well as extended medical coverage, and outplacement support.

As you might appreciate, this is a difficult time for our employees and we are spending our time addressing their concerns.
