The Eligible Training Provider List

Training providers are required by WIOA to meet eligibility criteria based on performance data to receive funding, such as:

- Number of participants
- Completion rates
- Credential rates
- Employment after completion

ETPL Objectives

This statewide list ensures the **accountability, quality, and labor-market relevance** of training programs that receive funds through WIOA.

Likewise, it is also a means for ensuring **informed customer choice** for individuals who are eligible for training services.

ETPL Exceptions

- On-the-Job training (OJT)
- Incumbent worker training
- Customized training
- Internships
- Transitional employment
- Paid or unpaid work experience opportunities

WIOA Implications

All work-based training programs are exempt from the ETPL eligibility criteria. For these programs the **state establishes the data** that the WDBs must collect to **identify quality providers** (employers) and then **share this information** with the One-Stop System.

Proposed Data

1. The **number of individuals** engaged in training for the project (by employer when there are multiple employers involved—participant level data)
2. The percent of individuals engaged in training for each employer who **completed** the training
3. Any **credentials** attained as a result of the training (by type)
4. The percent of individuals by employer who completed the training and received a **pay increase within 60** days of the end of training as a result of gaining skills; (we would need to know the start and end date of the training and data match with our wage records)
5. Of those individuals who completed the training and received a wage increase, the **average hourly wage increase** by employer
