Re: Extension of Temporary Furloughs at Hyatt Regency Indianapolis

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (hereinafter "WARN"), this letter shall serve as formal notice to advise that the temporary furloughs put in place between March 16, 2020 and January 18, 2021 at the Hyatt Regency Indianapolis, One South Capitol Ave., Indianapolis, IN 46204 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic will unfortunately continue beyond January 18, 2021. At this time, it is difficult to determine when all the COVID-19 restrictions shall be lifted and/or when occupancy will return to a level where we can reinstate employment of the furloughed employees at this Property. It is our intent to reinstate all furloughed employees once our business operations increase and we are financially able to do so.

Presently, we have 78 of the 159 employees who are on temporary furlough. These employees have been advised of the extension of their furlough. These employees have also been advised that the extension is necessary due to the business interruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic including compliance with federal and state regulations to slow the spread of COVID-19 and the delays in rolling out the vaccine that were not foreseeable at the time of the initial furlough.
