Who Gets Expelled?



Boys 3.5 times more than girls



4-year-olds twice more than 3-year-olds



African-Americans twice more than European-Americans and 5 times more than Asian-Americans

Who Expels More?

Expulsion rates are HIGHER when programs

- · keep more kids per teacher
- · have teachers who feel stressed
- · serve children for longer hours

Please pick up your child early. He hit again! He'll be a better fit in a DIFFERENT child care. Better to keep him some counseling.

Expulsion can create more trouble for everyone.

Parents miss work and lose jobs. Children are at greater risk for long-term problems.

- Train teachers to support social-emotional development and create developmentally appropriate learning environments
- Access early childhood mental health consultation
- Develop strong relationships with families
