SUBJECT: CY2024 Allowable Room and Board Rates

DATE: Nov. 2, 2023

The purpose of this memorandum is to update the allowable room and board rates for CY2024 that an assisted living facility may charge individuals who participate in Indiana's Aged and Disabled or Traumatic Brain Injury 1915(c) Home and Community- Based waiver or in the state's Money Follows the Person Demonstration program. This memorandum supersedes all previous communications regarding allowable room and board rates.

Under 455 IAC 3-1-12, participants living in assisted living facilities are entitled to retain at least their personal needs allowance as established by the state of Indiana, <u>found here</u>.

A provider, after assuring that the participants retain their PNA, may bill participants up to the current maximum Federal Supplemental Security Income. *The monthly maximum Federal SSI amount for 2024 is \$943 per month for an eligible individual based on an 3.2% cost of living increase.* Providers may not charge Medicaid eligible individuals a room and board rate for a studio apartment that exceeds the maximum SSI amount for 2024. A participant who wishes to select a larger room may pay extra for any unit exceeding the size of a studio based on the monthly amount determined by the facility.

Please see the three illustrations below for further clarification. The amounts included in the examples below are for illustrative purposes only. Providers are responsible for determining the current maximum SSI and the State PNA when calculating room and board rates. The current SSI may be <u>found here.</u> Per Ind. Code §12-15-7-2, the State PNA is \$52.



## Example 1: Medicaid Waiver Participant Receiving only SSI Income

Medicaid Waiver Participant Monthly Income\$943.00SSI for an Eligible Individual\$943.00PNA\$52.00Allowable Room and Board Rate\$891.00

## Example 2: Medicaid Waiver Participant with Income in Excess of the SSI Rate

Medicaid Waiver Participant Monthly Income\$954.00SSI for Eligible Individual\$943.00PNA\$52.00Allowable Room and Board Rate\$902.00

## Example3: Medicaid Waiver Participant with Income in Excess of the SSI Rate

Medicaid Waiver Participant Monthly Income\$1,229.00SSI for Eligible Individual\$943.00PNA\$52.00Allowable Room and Board Rate\$943.00

In all these examples, the participant retains their PNA and the room and board rate is no greater than the maximum SSI.
