

MADISON STATE HOSPITAL
Facility Fact Sheet
SFY 2009

Madison State Hospital (MSH) has served citizens of Indiana for nearly a century. In 2005, the Joint Commission accredited, Medicare and Medicaid certified hospital moved into its state-of-the-art treatment facility, created from a blend of historic restoration, renovation, and new construction overlooking the Ohio River. The innovative hospital structure parallels the overall mission of MSH to establish exemplary standards of psychiatric care with recovery as the goal.

The 150-bed facility serves individuals who struggle with the most severe mental health challenges. Unit names, such as Success Road, Recovery Road, and Healing Heights reflect Madison's philosophy of contemporary psychiatric treatment based on hope, empowerment, education, and positive self-identity. The units fall under two categories:

- **Adult Psychiatric Services:** 90 Beds
 - Recovery Road – 12 Bed Unit for males with moderate to high acuity psychiatric illness.
 - Success Road – 15 Bed Unit for males with moderate to high acuity psychiatric illness.
 - Harmony Lane – 18 Bed Unit for males with serious and persistent psychiatric illness.
 - Journey Way – 15 Bed Unit for females with moderate to high acuity psychiatric illness.
 - Healing Heights – 12 Bed Unit for individuals with serious and persistent psychiatric illness and co-morbid medical problems that are manageable in a free standing psychiatric hospital.
 - Wisdom Way – 18 Bed Unit for geriatric individuals with serious and persistent psychiatric illness.

- **Adult Mentally Retarded/Developmentally Disabled (MR/DD Services):** 60 Beds.
 - Hope Trail – Intermediate Care Facility for the Mentally Retarded (ICF/MR) – 15 Bed Unit for individuals age 18 and above that are diagnosed as MR/DD and in need of active treatment.
 - Victory Lane – Intermediate Care Facility for the Mentally Retarded (ICF/MR) – 15 Bed Unit for males age 18 and above that are diagnosed as MR/DD and in need of active treatment.
 - Serenity Way – 15 Bed Unit for individuals age 18 and above that are diagnosed as MR/DD, a serious and persistent mental illness, and in need of active treatment.
 - Progress Road – Intermediate Care Facility for the Mentally Retarded (ICF/MR) – 15 Bed Unit for individuals age 18 and above that are diagnosed as MR/DD and in need of active treatment.
