

Residential Services for Chemically Addicted Women
SFY 2009 (July 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Contractor shall provide residential treatment services for chemically addicted women including women who are pregnant and women with dependent children, as follows:

1. Within the limits of the contractor's capacity, the contractor shall accept referrals from other Indiana providers. On a quarterly basis, the contractor shall list the referrals received and referrals accepted from all Indiana providers.

2. These services shall be provided at no cost to those providers because the services are being paid for by the Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA). The contractor should register the individual being referred even if the referring provider has registered that individual. The contractor may seek payment from other sources such as insurance or Medicaid.

3. Contractor shall make the following services available to chemically addicted pregnant women, to chemically addicted women with dependent children, and to the dependent children:

- A. The delivery or referral for *primary medical care* for women;
- B. The delivery or referral for *primary pediatric care* for the women's dependent children;
- C. The provision of *gender specific* substance abuse treatment as follows:

- 1. women's specific group sessions
- 2. individual therapy as needed with gender specific therapeutic counseling
- 3. *Therapeutic interventions* for children;
- 4. *Case management*; and
- 5. Arrange for or directly provide the following:
 - a. *Child care* and,
 - b. *Transportation*.

4. Contractor shall provide the DMHA with quarterly reports detailing the following:
- A. the number of chemically addicted women receiving treatment,
 - B. the number of chemically addicted pregnant women receiving treatment,
 - C. the number of chemically addicted women with children receiving treatment, and
 - D. the number of dependent children receiving services.

Contractor shall report the total units of service delivered for items A through D above.

5. Contractor shall list specific services for women on the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Substance Abuse Treatment Facility Locator and shall otherwise publicize the availability of these services in the region.

6. The DMHA will pay contractor at the rate established in the *Attachment Document Detail* within the SFY 2009 Managed Care Provider contract.
