

## 2017-2018 Academic School Year Fee Schedule for Post-Secondary Education

Pursuant to 460 IAC 14-8-4(a), Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VR) funding for post-secondary expenses may not exceed the lesser of either the published fees and tuition costs of the training institution or program attended, or the fees established by the VR program.

All individuals interested in post-secondary assistance from VR must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to their post-secondary institution. The FAFSA is used to determine an individual's expected family contribution.

In accordance with 460 IAC 14-18-1(b), VR is the payer of last resort after an individual's expected family contribution and all comparable benefits including federal, state, institutional, private grants, scholarships and other gift awards have been used. VR excludes merit based scholarships and grants from the comparable benefits requirement. Additionally, VR does not consider the expected family contribution amount as a resource for post-secondary funding determinations for eligible individuals who receive Supplemental Security Income and/or Social Security Disability Insurance based upon their own disability.

The fee schedule for postsecondary education school expenses applies to all post-secondary institutions, including private colleges/universities, in-state institutions and out of state institutions.
