Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 11-724 and proposed by the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration ("FSSA"). The proposed rule amends 405 IAC 1-1-2, 405 IAC 1.1-1-3, 405 IAC 2-10-5, and 405 IAC 9-5-2 to make administrative changes to the time limits and procedures for filing appeal requests by applicants or recipients. The proposed rule also amends 405 IAC 2-3-24 to specify the time limits and procedures for filing a hardship exception request.

The economic impact statement prepared by the FSSA indicates that no small businesses will be impacted by the proposed rule.
