EXECUTIVE ORDER 05-34

**FOR: DECLARING A DISASTER EMERGENCY IN THE STATE OF INDIANA DUE TO
TORNADOES, SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS, EXTREMELY HIGH WINDS AND FLOODING**

TO ALL TO WHO THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

WHEREAS, multiple tornadoes, severe thunderstorms, extremely high winds and flooding swept through parts of Indiana on November 15, 2005;

WHEREAS, at least one Hoosier has been killed and numerous have been injured as a result of these storms;

WHEREAS, significant damage has been inflicted upon homes, businesses and private and public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Homeland Security has mobilized and deployed all available state resources to assist the victims, local officials and political subdivisions affected by this disaster.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby


DECLARE, that a state of disaster emergency exists in Indiana; and

ORDER the Indiana Department of Homeland Security, having already implemented the State Emergency Plan, to provide needed emergency services to the damaged areas of Indiana impacted by the storms and to coordinate assistance with appropriate federal and state agencies.

This declaration of disaster emergency was in effect beginning November 15, 2005 and continues.
