Dear Speaker Bauer and Members of the House of Representatives,

By the authority vested in me as Governor of Indiana, under the provisions of Article 5, Section 14, of the Constitution of the State of Indiana, I do hereby veto House Enrolled Act No. 1348, enacted during the regular session of the 116th General Assembly. While this bill does constitute good policy, it is completely superfluous. At my direction, the Indiana Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission began months ago the process of updating the state energy code to promote conservation and environmental protection. Accordingly, the language of the bill would only serve to clutter the existing Indiana Code without adding in any way to our progress in these areas.
