Indiana HIV Outbreak Response Update: Thursday, May 14, 2015

Current Situation

State health officials announced today that the number of HIV cases in the southeastern Indiana outbreak is now at 155 cases of HIV (154 confirmed and one preliminary positive).

One-Stop Shop Update at the Community Outreach Center

Services provided include: access to state-issued ID cards, birth certificates, job counseling and local training, enrollment in HIP 2.0 insurance, HIV testing, HIV care coordination, substance abuse referrals, and vaccinations against tetanus, Hepatitis A and B.
