### **Marker Text**

The first road to cross Indiana was blazed by Captain Ephraim Kibbey in 1799-1800. This two-hundred mile route ran from Cincinnati to Vincennes, crossing the Greene Ville Treaty Line here.

### **Report**

This marker was located at SR 350 (South side) near Ripley County line. It is now missing. It would be difficult to prove that this was the "first" road. More research would be needed if the marker is located.
