The year 2009 began the first full year in which the Indiana racing programs reaped the benefits of slot enhanced purses. The 2009 program offered record purses in many areas. You will continue to see the benefits of the slots revenues in the improvements made to the 2010 program which include:

- ◆ *Increased purses for Indiana Sires Stakes legs & finals.*
- ◆ *Purses for all Indiana Sired Late Closers have been increased.*
- ◆ *Purses for overnight races which fill with all Indiana Sired horses will be boosted by 30%.*
- ◆ *The Indiana Sired Bonus has been increased. First place bonus will be 15% of the total purse, with the bonus for second place being paid at 5% of the total purse.*
- ◆ *Breeder Awards have been increased to 8%.*
- ◆ *Purses for Indiana Sired Fair Circuit Championship and Consolation races have been increased.*

You will find the many racing opportunities for Indiana Sired Horses highlighted in this book. Indiana Sired Horses continue to break records and cross boundaries each year. I look forward to see what new accomplishments are in store and predict that 2010 will be another exciting and memorable year for racing in Indiana.

Hoosier Home Run Award

"Step up to the Plate" for the Triple Crown of Indiana Harness Racing

Sponsor: Hoosier Hoofprints

For: Three-year-olds of a given year sired by stallions registered in the Indiana Stallion Registry the year the foals were conceived.

Hoosier Home Run Award & Amount: An award paid to the owner/lessee of any three-year-old Indiana-sired horse winning all three events comprising the Indiana-sired Triple Crown. The Bonus is paid to the owner/lessee following the final leg of the three races (pending clearance of post-race laboratory testing results) in the following amount: **\$25,000/award**

The three (3) events comprising the Indiana-sired Triple Crown include:

- **Indiana Sires Stakes Final – Series 1**
- **Elkhart County Classic Pace or Maple City Trot**
- **Indiana Sires Stakes Final – Series 2**

This is an incentive award, encouraging trainers/owners to stake their horses and participate in all three (3) of these events during their sophomore season. A maximum of four (4) awards will be paid each year. Both colts/geldings & fillies are eligible to earn the award.

Please note: The Hoosier Home Run Award is paid by the Indiana Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and is not added to the horse's earnings.

Owner Defined: For the purpose of the Hoosier Home Run Award, the owner is defined as the individual whose name appears as owner on the official judges' sheet for the final race in the group. (Unless the owner is listed incorrectly, due to sale, etc. and proper documentation can be produced). In the case of leased horses, if the lessee is listed as the official owner on the judges' sheet, the Hoosier Home Run Award will be paid to the lessee. ***If there are multiple owners/lessees listed, the award will be paid to the first individual listed with the USTA. It is that individual's responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed owners/lessees.***

To Be Raced As: Three separate events, as described in the individual race conditions. Locations for the events are designated annually by the Sponsors of the events comprising the Indiana-sired Triple Crown.

Additional Fees: Nomination to the Three-year-old Indiana Sires Stakes and either the Elkhart County Classic Pace or the Maple City Trot is required to be eligible to earn this award. Indiana-sired three-year-olds not otherwise eligible to the Elkhart County Classic Pace (or Maple City Trot) as of the nomination deadline, may, with a payment of **\$5,000 (in addition to the regular entry fee)**, supplement to the second leg of the Hoosier Home Run, the Elkhart County Classic Pace (or Maple City Trot). See specific race conditions for details.

Additional Emergency Award Conditions:

1. If for any reason, including but not limited to, weather, it becomes impossible to race any of the events involved in earning this award, the award shall be cancelled for the year.
2. The Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board and Indiana Standardbred Breed Development Advisory Committee will have the final decision in any dispute concerning this award.

Mini-Series Rules

Hoosier Park and Indiana Downs will have a variety of Mini-Series during the 2010 race meet for Indiana Sired horses. These series will appear on the overnight sheet and do not require a nomination or starting fee. *For more information, please contact Jessica Barnes at (317) 233-3120 or the Race Secretary at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs.*

1. **Nominations:** There are no nomination or starting fees required.

2. **Race Conditions:**

1. All horses must meet Hoosier Park qualifying standards in order to be eligible to compete in Mini-Series.
2. To be raced as an elimination(s) and a final.
3. No trainer or owner may race more than two (2) horses per division in a Mini-Series, elimination or final.
4. If there are fourteen (14) or fewer entries, twelve (12) starters will be determined by preference date, and also eligibles will be drawn. If there are fifteen (15) or more eligible entries the race will be split into divisions.
5. Eliminations or finals will only take place if there are eight (8) or more betting interests, and may take place with seven (7) at the track's discretion.
6. Horses with the highest money earnings from the elimination(s) who declare into the box will compete in the final. To be eligible for the final, a horse must have started in an elimination. The final will be limited to ten (10) horses. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be decided by toss of a coin. Two (2) also eligibles for the final may be selected from the next two (2) highest money earners. If there are eight or more additional eligible entries, a consolation for the next group of top point earners may be held at the discretion of the race secretary at elimination purse levels.
7. No owner and/or trainer will be permitted to race two (2) horses in a Mini-Series to the exclusion of a single entry.
8. In order for a Mini-Series Final to be held a certain number of legs scheduled must be raced.

3. **Claiming Mini Series:**

1. Horses may be claimed out of the elimination races or the final of these series.
2. Claiming Allowances: 2 yr olds – 100%, 3 yr olds – 50%, 4 yr olds – 25%, Mares – 20%
3. All horses must have a registration certificate and a current claiming authorization on file in the racing office.

4. **Conditioned Mini Series:** Horses which are eligible prior to the elimination of a series, will remain eligible for final, regardless of their winnings after the elimination race.

Standardbred Breed Development Policy on Indiana Sired & Indiana Bred Bonus and Breeder's Award Payments

Indiana Sired (IS) Bonus/ Indiana Bred (IB) Bonus

Indiana Bred Bonus (IB): An award paid to any Indiana Bred horse competing in open company (a race not restricted to Indiana Bred Horses) at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs that finishes first or second. Please note that the award will not be paid on any race classified as \$4000 or \$5000 Claiming. The award will be paid to the owner of the Indiana Bred horse. Indiana bred horses are defined as follows:

Breeders are as registered by the USTA. Any and all breeders of the horse must be Indiana residents. Any partnership or corporation registered by the USTA as breeder must be totally composed of Indiana residents.

Indiana Sired Bonus (IS): An award paid to any Indiana Sired horse competing in open company (a race not restricted to Indiana Sired Horses) at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs that finishes first or second. Please note that the award will not be paid on any race classified as \$4000 or \$5000 Claiming. This is an incentive award encouraging trainers/owners to enter their horses into open company.

Owner Defined: For the purpose of the IS Bonus and IB Bonus Award, the owner is defined as the individual whose name appears as owner on the official judges sheet for the race in question (*Unless the owner is listed incorrectly*). If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. In the case of leased horses, if the lessee is listed as the official owner on the judges sheet, the IS Bonus will be paid to the lessee. ***If there are multiple owners/lessees listed, the award will be paid to the first individual listed with the USTA. It is that individual's responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed owners/lessees.***

Amount of IS Bonus/IB Bonus: The Bonus is paid to the owner/lessee of the Indiana Sired horse in the following amounts:

1st Place Finish: 15% of the total purse for that race.

2nd Place Finish: 5% of the total purse for that race.

Please note: The IS Bonus is paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and the award is not added to the horse's earnings.

If a horse is eligible for both an Indiana Sired Bonus and Indiana Bred Bonus, the horse will only receive one bonus.

Indiana Sired Breeder Awards

Breeder Award: An award in the amount of 8% of the Total Purse paid to the Breeder of an Indiana Sired eligible horse.

Breeder Defined: The breeder is the individual listed on the horse's registration papers as the breeder by the USTA. If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. *If there are multiple breeders listed, the award will be paid to the individual listed first. It is the individual who receives the awards responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed breeders.*

Who is Eligible for a Breeder's Award?: The breeder of the winning horse of the following:

- Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
- Leg or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
- Indiana Sired Fair Circuit Championship Races
- Any horse winning the track's open or invitational race.
- Any 2 or 3 year old Indiana Sired horse winning any other race not listed above.

Please Note: Breeder's Awards are paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and the award is not added to the horse's earnings.

Please note: In order to receive an award, you must have a completed W-9 & Direct Deposit From on file with the State of Indiana.






