Dear Standardbred Owner:

The year 2011 was another exciting one for the Standardbred Industry in Indiana. Records continue to be broken, not only by outstanding Indiana horses, but also in regards to the amount of purses awarded. The Indiana Sires Stakes program distributed purses amounting to over \$11.2 million dollars. An additional \$2.2 million was paid out to horses competing at Indiana fairs. Overall, the Standardbred Breed Development program distributed over \$19 million dollars to owners and breeders of Indiana Sired horses during 2011.

The population of Indiana Sired horses continue to grow, while the funding the program receives does not. In putting the program together for 2012, adjustments had to be made in order to accommodate this growth and the slight decreases in funding that the Breed Development Program has experienced. What remains is a strong, viable and sustainable program for 2012. While the program is explained in detail in this booklet, I would like to highlight a few items that you should be aware of, they are:

- Indiana Sires Stakes has become a multi-tiered program. The Indiana Sires Stakes consists of a Gold and Silver level. A single nomination payment makes your Indiana Sired horse eligible to both levels, however for any given leg or final you must choose between the Gold or Silver Division. In addition, points will only be awarded in the division they are earned and will not transfer.
- Two-year olds must be Indiana Sired and Bred (ISB) in order to participate in the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit Program, receive Breeder's Awards or Bonus payments. For a listing of ISB foals, please visit our website at www.in.gov/hrc.
- The format of the Indiana Breeder's and Bonus Awards has been changed. The awards will be distributed to eligible breeders/owners based on the horse's win earnings percentage in the pool of all eligible horses. You can find a detailed explanation of this program on page five of this booklet.

In addition, there are many races detailed in this booklet, each having differing race conditions, nomination deadlines and payment addresses. Please pay close attention to this as you nominate your horses. If you need additional nomination forms, you may download them from our website at www.in.gov/hrc.

Mini-Series Rules

Hoosier Park and Indiana Downs will have a variety of Mini-Series during the 2012 race meet for Indiana Sired horses. These series will appear on the overnight sheet and do not require a nomination or starting fee. For more information, please contact Jessica Barnes at (317) 233-3119 or the Race Secretary at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs.

- 1. Nominations:** There are no nomination or starting fees required.
- 2. Race Conditions:**
 1. All horses must meet host track qualifying standards in order to be eligible to compete in Mini-Series.
 2. To be raced as an elimination(s) and a final.
 3. No trainer or owner may race more than two (2) horses per division in a Mini-Series, elimination or final.
 4. If there are fourteen (14) or fewer entries, twelve (12) starters will be determined by preference date, and also eligibles will be drawn. If there are fifteen (15) or more eligible entries the race will be split into divisions.
 5. Eliminations or finals will only take place if there are eight (8) or more betting interests, and may take place with seven (7) at the track's discretion.
 6. Horses with the highest point earnings from the elimination(s) who declare into the box will compete in the final. To be eligible for the final, a horse must have started in an elimination. The final will be limited to ten (10) horses. If there is a tie for tenth (10th) place, entry will be drawn by lot. Two (2) also eligibles for the final may be selected from the next two (2) highest point earners. If there are eight or more additional eligible entries, a consolation for the next group of top point earners may be held at the discretion of the race secretary at elimination purse levels.
 7. No owner and/or trainer will be permitted to race two (2) horses in a Mini-Series to the exclusion of a single entry.
- 3. Claiming Mini Series:**
 1. Horses may be claimed out of the elimination races or the final of these series.
 2. Claiming Allowances: 2 yr olds – 100%, 3 yr olds – 50%, 4 yr olds – 25%,
Mares – 20%
- 4. Conditioned Mini Series:** Horses which are eligible prior to the elimination of a series will remain eligible for final, regardless of their winnings after the elimination race.

2012 Standardbred Breed Development Policy on Indiana Sired & Indiana Bred Bonus and Breeder's Award Payments

Indiana Sired (IS) Bonus/ Indiana Bred (IS) Bonus

Indiana Bred Bonus (IB): An award paid to any Indiana Bred horse competing in open company (a race not restricted to Indiana Bred Horses) at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs that finishes first. Please note that the race must be classified as \$8000 Claiming (Base Claiming Price) or above. The award will be paid to the owner of the Indiana Bred horse based on percentage win earnings of the total win earnings available. Indiana bred horses are defined as follows:

***For Foals of 2010 & beyond:** A foal from a mare which was registered & resided in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st for foals of 2010 and 2011, and August 1st for foals of 2012 and beyond of the breeding year through the time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the IHRC.

***For Foals of 2009 and prior:** Breeders are as registered by the USTA. Any and all breeders of the horse must be Indiana residents. Any partnership or corporation registered by the USTA as breeder must be totally composed of Indiana residents.

Indiana Sired & Bred Bonus (ISB): An award paid to any Indiana Sired & Bred horse competing in open company (a race not restricted to Indiana Sired Horses) at Hoosier Park or Indiana Downs that finishes first. Please note that the race must be classified as \$8000 Claiming (Base Claiming Price) or above. The award will be paid to the owner of the Indiana Sired horse based on percentage win earnings of the total win earnings available. This is an incentive award encouraging trainers/owners to enter their horses into open company. Indiana Sired & Bred horses are defined as follows:

***For Foals of 2010 & beyond:** A foal sired by a registered Indiana stallion and from a mare which was registered & resided in the State of Indiana continuously from June 1st for foals of 2010 and 2011, and August 1st for foals of 2012 and beyond of the breeding year through the time of foaling and (30) thirty days after and is properly registered with the IHRC.

***For Foals of 2009 & prior:** A foal sired by a stallion standing in Indiana and registered with the IHRC the year the foal was conceived.

Owner Defined: For the purpose of the ISB Bonus and IB Bonus Award, the owner is defined as the individual whose name appears as owner on the official judges sheet for the race in question (*Unless the owner is listed incorrectly*). If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. In the case of leased horses, if the lessee is listed as the official owner on the judges sheet, the IS Bonus will be paid to the lessee. ***If there are multiple owners/lessees listed, the award will be paid to the first individual listed with the USTA. It is that individual's responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed owners/lessees.***

Amount of ISB Bonus/IB Bonus: The Bonus is paid to the owner/lessee of the Indiana Sired horse through using the following formula:

$$\text{Owner's Bonus Amt} = \% \text{ of win earnings in eligible races} * \text{Amt Available } (\$500,000)$$

Please note: Bonuses will be paid on an annual bases at the completion of the last race meet in Indiana. Bonuses are paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and the award is not added to the horse's earnings.

Indiana Sired & Bred Breeder Awards

Breeder Award: An award paid to the registered breeder of the Indiana Sired & Bred horse through using the following formula:

$$\text{Breeder's Awd Amt} = \% \text{ of win earnings in eligible races} * \text{Amt of available } (\$700,000)$$

Breeder Defined: The breeder is the individual listed on the horse's registration papers as the breeder by the USTA. If the award is to be paid to a stable name/business then the registered owner must be listed as that stable name/business. ***If there are multiple breeders listed, the award will be paid to the individual listed first. It is the individual who receives the awards responsibility to distribute the award to the remaining listed breeders.***

Who is Eligible for a Breeder's Award?: The horse must win an eligible race to be eligible to the Breeder's Award Pool. The criteria is as follows:

- Two Year Olds - Indiana Sired & Bred (ISB) Horses only that win any race at the Pari-Mutual Tracks in Indiana or ISFC Championship Races.
- Three Year Olds - Indiana Sired (IS) Horses that win any race the Pari-Mutual Track in Indiana or ISFC Championship Races.
- Aged Horses (Four Year Olds & Older) that win:
 - *Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - *Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - *Track's Open or Invitational Race

Please Note: Breeder's Awards will be paid on an annual basis, at the completion of the last race meet in Indiana. Breeder's Awards are paid by the Standardbred Breed Development Program, not the racetrack, and the award is not added to the horse's earnings.

Please Note: In order to receive an award, you must have a completed W-9 & Direct Deposit Form on file with the State of Indiana.



5. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the condition sheet.

General Conditions for the 2012 Indiana Sired Fair Circuit Program (For Two and Three Year Olds in 2012)

Sponsor: Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board)
For: Fair races for foals of 2009, sired by stallions registered in the Indiana Stallion Registry the year the foals were conceived. For Indiana Sired & Bred foals of 2010, as defined by 71 IAC 14-1-3. Championship races at the Indiana State Fair to be held for foals of 2009 and foals of 2010.

To Be Raced As: One level for 2 and 3 Year Old Trotters and Pacers in 2012. Also to be raced as a Championship and Consolation race at the Indiana State Fair for 2 and 3 year old Trotters and Pacers in 2012 based on points earned in the Fair Circuit. A second series of races following the Indiana State Fair with a Championship based on points earned in this series. In order to be eligible for Series 2, the following eligibility requirements must be met:
 Two Year Olds - NW \$40,000 in 2012 up to and including 9/1/12
 Three Year Olds - NW \$50,000 in 2012 up to and including 9/1/12

To Be Raced At: Locations to be designated annually by the Sponsor.
Nominations: **Two Year Olds:** April 15, 2012 - \$300
Three Year Olds: March 15, 2012 - \$300

Future Payments: No sustaining fees due.
Entry Fees: (Payable to Host Track)
Once a horse is drawn into a ISFC event, the entry fee is due, even if the horse is scratched. If entry fee is not paid, the horse will be ineligible to start in all subsequent fairs.
 Entry Fee.....\$50.00
Please Note: There will be no entry fee required for the Championship or Consolation race, but horses must check in at the race office one hour prior to the post time for the 1st race.

Future Eligibility: If the two year old nominating payment is not made, an eligible foal may be nominated as a three year old or older.

Entry Fee: To be paid at the office of the director of racing at each host track prior to the start of the races.
Money Division: Purses will be paid 50-25-12-8-5 percent.
Race Conditions: Each two-year-old event is to be raced one heat at one mile each. Each three year old event will be raced either one or two heats at the option of the host track. There are no eliminations. The event may be raced in divisions, according to USTA rules with the following exceptions:
 • If there is a minimum of five fillies and five colts in the specified level, the race will be split into divisions based on sex. If the minimum of five (5) entries is not met, the race will not be contested.
 • If the minimum of five fillies and/or five colts is not met, all entries for that level will be in division(s) to be drawn at lot, with fillies drawing the inside post positions.
 • No horse may compete in any ISFC event who has raced in any other race on the day of, or on any two (2) days prior to the event (qualifiers and rained-out ISFC events excluded).
 • No horse may compete in any ISFC event who has raced in an Indiana Sires (ISS) event five (5) days prior to the event.

Emergency: If for any reason, including but not limited to, weather, it becomes impossible to race any of the events at the host site, it is at the discretion of the Indiana Standardbred Advisory Board (Board) to contest any of these races at a different time and place so designated by the Board. The Board reserves the right to call off the event, and return to the entrants their pro-rated share of the accumulated horsemen portion of the purse, after deducting the clerical and administrative expenses allowed in these conditions. All entrants must abide by this change or forfeit their right to participate in these races or race for any part of the purse. In all circumstances, the Board will make the final decision.


Gait: Horses changing gait may be transferred to their adopted gait but payments made prior to that time will not be transferred.

Rules: Rules of the United States Trotting Association shall govern unless otherwise specified in these conditions or under the rules and regulations of the Board.

Championship Races: There will be Championship and Consolation races held for both Series 1 & Series 2. The purse for the Championship race will be \$20,000 and the Consolation will be \$8,000. Of those that have declared to race at the Indiana State Fair (Series 1), the top eight (8) point earners that have participated in (or credited with) at least seven (7) Indiana Sired Fair Circuit races will be selected as starters for the Championship race and the next eight (8) point earners that have participated in (or credited with) at least seven (7) Indiana Sired Fair Circuit races will be selected as starters for the Consolation race. The Championship will be limited to eight (8) horses. When two or more horses are tied for eighth (8th) place, then one horse from those tied will be drawn at lot to fill a Championship race. The Consolation will also be limited to eight (8) horses. When two or more horses are tied for eighth (8th) place, then one horse from those tied will be drawn by lot to fill the Consolation. **The Consolation must have a minimum of five entries to take place.** There will be no combining of sexes in Consolation races. Horses competing in the Championship and Consolation (if applicable) race for Series 2 must have participated in (or credited with) at least three (3) starts in Series 2 and starters will be selected in the same manner as defined for Series 1 Championship and Consolations.
Please Note: Horses racing at the ISFC Races shall be subject to Blood Gas Testing.
 All starters will receive one point for each heat raced. Points for the Championship and Consolation shall be calculated according to the placing of the judges and shall determine what horses shall qualify for the Championship and Consolation, notwithstanding any appeal from the judge's decision that is final. If for any reason, including but not limited to, weather, it becomes impossible to race one or two heat race at a host track, all horses entered will be awarded one point and credited with a start. No points will be awarded to a horse that is scratched or for any races that do not fill.
